INTRODUCTION TO THE SKILL

Idea generation is the first step to finding a solution to a problem. It can assist you when you are stuck with something and help businesses to develop and become more successful. Idea generation is likewise efficient and can save you from wasting valuable time. Having good idea-generation techniques can help you be more creative and productive in your work. It allows you to be open to new ways of thinking, expanding your range of thinking.

Idea evaluation is then used to see whether these generated ideas are good or bad. These two techniques co-exist with one another and usually do not work without each other. Idea evaluation allows you to select your best ideas faster and as effectively as possible.

- It is important to consider all aspects of your idea, the positives, and negatives, to really see if your idea will be truly successful or not. If your idea turns out to not be a winning idea, can you do anything to make it better?

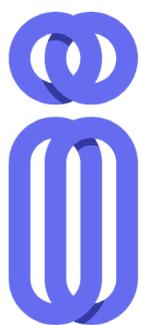
